1. Grant of License. Subject to the terms of the this Agreement, You hereby grant to CSF, a perpetual, non-exclusive, irrevocable, worldwide, no-charge (fully-paid), royalty-free, sublicenseable, transferable license under all Your relevant intellectual property rights (including copyright, patent and any other rights), to use, copy, reproduce, prepare derivative works of, distribute, sublicense, and publically perform and display the Contribution on any licensing terms, including without limitation: (a) open source licenses like the GNU General Public License (GPL), the GNU Lesser General Public License (LGPL), GNU Affero General Public License (AGPL), the Mozilla Public License (MPL), the Common Public License, or the Berkley Science Division license (BSD); and (b) binary, proprietary, or commercial licenses.
2. Ownership of Rights. You represent that You are legally entitled to grant the above license. If Your employer has rights or may claim rights to intellectual property that You create, You represent that you have received permission to make the Contribution on behalf of that employer, or that Your employer has waived in writing such rights for the Contribution.
3. Original Work. You represent that the Contribution is Your original works of authorship, and to Your knowledge, no other person claims, or has the right to claim, any right in any invention or patent related to the Contribution.
4. Our Discretion. You understand that the decision to include the Contribution in any product or source repository is entirely that of CSF, and this Agreement does not guarantee that the Contribution will be included in any product.
